

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 11-27, as amended, by amending section 1 to apportion funds for the State of Chuuk, by further amending section 3, as amended by Public Law No. 11-55, to modify the use of funds appropriated therein for the State of Yap, and by further amending section 5, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 11-39 and 11-55, to provide allottees for the newly created uses of funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 11-27 is hereby amended  
2 to read as follows:

3           "Section 1. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the  
5 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for  
6 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2000, for the  
7 purpose of funding infrastructure projects, roads, and  
8 other economic and social projects and programs in the  
9 State of Chuuk. The funds appropriated under this  
10 section shall be apportioned as follows:

13 Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 11-27, as amended by  
14 Public Law No. 11-55, is hereby further amended to read as  
15 follows:

16 "Section 3. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof  
17 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the  
18 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for  
19 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2000, for the  
20 purpose of funding infrastructure projects, roads, and  
21 other economic and social projects and programs in the  
22 State of Yap. The funds appropriated under this  
23 section shall be apportioned as follows:

20 Section 3. Section 5 of Public Law No. 11-27, as amended by  
21 Public Laws Nos. 11-39 and 11-55, is hereby further amended to  
22 read as follows:

23 "Section 5. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date.

24 (1) All funds appropriated by this act shall be

1           allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in  
2           accordance with applicable law, including, but not  
3           limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
4           allottee of the funds appropriated by section 1 of this  
5           act shall be the Executive Director of Chuuk State  
6           Commission on Improvement Projects, or his designee.  
7           The allottee of the funds appropriated by subsections  
8           1, subsections 3 through 10, and subsection 13 of  
9           section 3 of this act shall be the Governor of the  
10          State of Yap. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
11          by subsections 2 and 11 of section 3 of this act shall  
12          be the Secretary of the Department of Transportation,  
13          Communication and Infrastructure. The allottee of the  
14          funds appropriated under subsection 12 of section 3 of  
15          this act shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the  
16          Federated States of Micronesia. The allottee of the  
17          funds appropriated by subsection 1 and subsection 3(a),  
18          3(b) and 3(d) of section 4 of this act shall be the  
19          Governor of Kosrae State. The allottee of the funds  
20          appropriated by subsection 3(c) of section 4 of this  
21          act shall be the Secretary of the Department of Finance  
22          and Administration, or his designee. The allottee of  
23          the funds appropriated by subsection 2 of section 4 of  
24          this act shall be the mayors of the respective  
25          municipalities, PROVIDED that, the mayors shall consult  
26          with the Kosrae Congressional Delegation Members before  
27          obligating funds. The allottee of all other funds

1           appropriated by this act shall be the President of the  
2           Federated States of Micronesia or the President's  
3           designee. The allottees shall not obligate funds  
4           appropriated under this act without consultation on the  
5           most appropriate usage of said funds between allottee  
6           and the relevant Congressional Delegation. The  
7           allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
8           funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used  
9           solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that  
10          no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
11          appropriated.

12                 (2) The authority of the allottees to obligate funds  
13          appropriated by this act shall not lapse."

14          Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
15          President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
16          becoming law without such approval.
