

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 13-36 to specify the use of certain funds appropriated therein, to change the allottee of certain funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 13-36 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

9 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 13-36 is hereby
10 amended to read as follows:

11 "Section 2. The sum of \$400,000, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
13 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
14 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2004, to provide
15 funding for social and economic development projects in
16 the State of Yap. The funds appropriated under this
17 section shall be apportioned as follows:

18 (1) Post-secondary scholarships for Yapese students,
19 subject to the following conditions:

20 (a) funds appropriated under this subsection may
21 only be used for tuition, books, and on-campus room and
22 board expenses;

23 (b) the maximum amount available to any
24 individual student enrolled at an institution of higher
25 education located outside the FSM is \$7,000;

1 (c) the maximum amount available to any individual
2 student enrolled at the College of Micronesia is \$1,500;
3 and

4 (d) if the FSM Scholarship Board does not meet to
5 award scholarship funds appropriated by this section,
6 the Secretary of the FSM Department of Health, Education
7 and Social Affairs (HESA), or his designee, and the Yap
8 State member of the FSM Scholarship Board may determine
9 the recipients of such funds\$ 180,000

10 (2) Fuel and other provisions for travel
11 by FSM government officials to Yap State Outer
12 Islands 28,000

13 (3) Yap State Copra subsidies 50,000

14 (4) Yap Network Newspaper equipment 20,000

15 (5) Yap Delegation office construction,

19 Section 3. Section 3 of Public Law No. 13-36 is hereby

21 "Section 3. The sum of \$800,000, or so much thereof as
22 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
23 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
24 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2004, to provide
25 funding for social and economic development projects in

1 the State of Pohnpei. The funds appropriated under this
2 section shall be apportioned as follows:

3 (1) Pohnpei Chamber of Commerce - Travel of
4 Businessmen to United States\$ 20,000

4 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
5 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2004, to provide
6 funding for social and economic development projects in
7 the State of Chuuk. The funds appropriated under this
8 section shall be apportioned as follows:

17 Section 5. Section 5 of Public Law No. 13-36 is hereby
18 amended to read as follows:

19 "Section 5. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
20 date.

21 (1) All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed by the
22 allottee of the funds appropriated under sections 1, 2
23 and 3 of this act shall be the President of the
24 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee, except
25 that the allottee of the funds appropriated under

1 subsections 1(1), 1(3) and 1(4) of this act shall be the
2 Governor of the State of Kosrae; the allottee of the
3 funds appropriated under sections 2(3) and 2(4) of this
4 act shall be the Governor of the State of Yap; the
5 allottee of the funds appropriated under sections 2(5)
6 and 2(6) shall be the Speaker of Congress; the allottee
7 of the funds appropriated under subsection 3(2)(a)(i)
8 shall be the mayor of Kolonia Town; the allottee of the
9 funds appropriated under subsections 3(2)(a)(ii),
10 3(2)(a)(iv) and 3(2)(a)(v) shall be the Sokehs
11 magistrate; and the allottee of the funds appropriated
12 under subsection 3(2)(a)(iii) shall be the mayor of
13 Nukuoro. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
14 section 4 of this act shall be the Chuuk State
15 Commission on Improvement Projects, except that the
16 funds appropriated under section 4(1)(c) of this act
17 shall be allotted to the President of the Federated
18 States of Micronesia.

19 (2) The allottees of the funds appropriated herein
20 shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or
21 so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for
22 the purpose specified herein, and shall report back to
23 the Congress on the status of these funds no later than
24 September 30, 2005. The authority of the allottees to

1 obligate such funds shall not lapse until fully
2 expended."

3 Section 6. This act shall become law upon approval by the
4 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
5 becoming law without such approval.
