**PUBLIC LAW NO. 19-02**

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AN ACT

To appropriate a supplemental budget in the amount of \$1,954,482 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2015, by amending sections 1, 2, 3, 8, and 9 of Public Law No. 18-89, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-102, 18-110, and 18-116, to change the conditions of certain funds therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 18-89, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 18-102, 18-110, and 18-116, is hereby further  
3 amended to read as follows:

4           "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to  
5           appropriate the sum of \$98,453,248 from the General Fund  
6           of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal  
7           year ending September 30, 2015, for the purpose of  
8           funding the operations of all branches of the National  
9           Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its  
10          agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and  
11          contributions and Capital and Human Resources  
12          Development. The National Government's share of the  
13          Amended Compact funds has been reduced to zero except  
14          that the National Government will retain ten percent  
15          (10%) of the Supplemental Education Grant funds as is  
16          reflected in the budget for the Department of Education.  
17          The budget shall also include appropriations for COM-FSM  
18          from sector grants as well as appropriations from

1 amended Compact carry-over funds.”

2 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 18-89, as amended by  
3 Public Laws Nos. 18-102, 18-110, and 18-116, is hereby further  
4 amended to read as follows:

5 “Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch.  
6 The sum of \$18,747,661, or so much thereof as may be  
7 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund  
8 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal  
9 year ending September 30, 2015, for the purpose of  
10 funding the operations of the Executive Branch of the  
11 National Government during the fiscal year 2015. The  
12 sum appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as  
13 follows:
