CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 4-161, C.D.1

AN ACT

To further amend title 2 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 3-24, by amending sections 203 and 204 for the purposes of establishing a Department of Transportation; eliminating the Department of Social Services; establishing the Office of Education and the Office of Health Services; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 203 of title 2 of the Code of the Federated
2 States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 203. Departments.

4 (1) There shall be the following departments which
5 shall be responsible for major programs or administrative
6 support areas in the Government of the Federated States:

- 7 (a) Department of Finance;
- 8 (b) Department of External Affairs;
- 9 (c) Department of Resources and Development; and
- 10 (d) Department of Transportation.

11 (2) The administrative head of each department shall
12 be designated as a 'Secretary.'

13 Section 2. Section 204 of title 2 of the Code of the Federated
14 States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:

15 "Section 204. Other executive offices. There shall be the
16 following executive offices:

- 17 (1) Office of the Attorney General;
- 18 (2) Office of Budget;
- 19 (3) Office of Information;
- 20 (4) Office of Personnel;
- 21 (5) Office of Planning and Statistics;
- 22 (6) Office of the Public Defender;



- 1 (7) Office of Education; and
2 (8) Office of Health Services."

3 Section 3. Until such time as appropriate amendments can be
4 made to statutes enacted prior to or during the same congressional
5 session as this act, the following transitional rules of statutory
6 construction shall apply to such statutes:

7 (1) Any reference to the Department of Social Services,
8 Division of Education, Division of Health Services, or Division of
9 Transportation shall be construed as applying to the appropriate
10 successor entity.

11 (2) Any reference to any official or employee of an
12 entity referred to in subsection (1) of this section shall be construed
13 as applying to the person holding the same or most similar position in
14 the appropriate successor entity.

15 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
16 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
17 law without such approval.
