DISTRICT COURT CRIMINAL CASE NO. 373/80 THE REPUBLIC V DAVID DENGOA

JUDGMENT

The accused is convicted in the earlier numbered case Criminal Case 372/80 where offence is in September 1980 while this charge is on 2rd July 1980. Accused admits all facts and pleads guilty on both the counts of the charge. He regrets for his conduct and assures that he would never give room for such a thing to happen again. He is working for N.P.C. and is 25 years of age. Indeed he is a first offender. With these observations keeping in view that he has been convicted on the other case referred above, I accept the plea of guilty of accused for the offence charged and sentence him to one month imprisonment with hard labour for the charge on count 1 and further sentence him to pay a fine of \$50 on count 2 of the charge and i d. one months h 1.

His driving licence is suspended in a period of six months from this day.

The sentence on count 1 of the charge in this case to run concurrently with the sentence awarded in criminal case no. 372/80.
