Facts

On 24th December 1980 at 2125 hours, police officers travelling to Buada met a vehicle coming down the hill with no headlights. They made a U turn and pursued the vehicle and stopped it opposite the calcination plant and found accused to be the driver. They also found him to have consumed liquor, had bloodshot eyes and speech was slurred and detained him accordingly.

Accused

Agrees with the facts - first offender.

Court

Count 1 - convicted and fined \$50.00, driving licence suspended for six months
In default of payments, 5 days imprisonment.

Count 2 - convicted and fined \$10.00, i.d. 2 days imprisonment

Fines to be paid by April 10th.
