A N O R D I N A N C E

To amend the Public Health Ordinance 1925

I, the Administrator of the Island of Nauru, do hereby enact, order and proclaim as under :-

1. -(1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Health Ordinance 1936.

(2). The Public Health Ordinance 1925, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3). The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Public Health Ordinance 1925-1936.

2. After section three of the Principal Ordinance the following sections are inserted :-

"3A. In this Ordinance, unless the contrary intention appears -

'Close settlement area' means any area declared by the Administrator by notice in the Gazette to be a close Settlement;

'Stock' includes any pig.

"3B. The Government Medical Officer shall, as directed by the Administrator, make an inspection of any close settlement area, and furnish a written report thereon.

"3C. The Administrator, upon receiving a report from the Government Medical Officer, may, by notice, require any holder of a leasehold in a close settlement area to take such measures as the Administrator thinks fit, for the exclusion of stock from any close settlement area.

"3D. Any leaseholder who fails to comply with the notice referred to in the last preceding section shall be guilty of an offence, and shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty not exceeding Two pounds."
