

To adopt the Regulations made under the Trade Marks Act 1955-1958 of the Commonwealth.

I, The Administrator of the Island of Nauru, in pursuance of the powers conferred by Article 1 of the Agreement dated the second day of July, 1919, between the Government of the United Kingdom, the Government of Australia and the Government of New Zealand, hereby make the following Ordinance.

TRADE MARKS REGULATIONS ADOPTION ORDINANCE 1964.

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Trade Marks Regulations Adoption Ordinance 1964.[ⓧ]

Extension of regulations under Trade Marks Act 1955-1958 to Nauru.

2. For the purposes of the application of the Trade Marks Act 1955-1958, the regulations made under that Act and in force from time to time shall, subject to the next succeeding section, apply to Nauru.

Administrator may modify regulations.

3. The Administrator may give such directions as he considers necessary in the circumstances of a particular case modifying the provisions of the regulations referred to in the last preceding section, and any directions so given have effect according to their tenor and notwithstanding anything contained in those regulations.
