**REPUBLIC OF NAURU  
PARLIAMENTARY POWERS, PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES ACT, 1976  
SECTION 30  
PARLIAMENTARY POWERS, PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES (RULES) 1996**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Speaker of Parliament by Section 30 of the Parliamentary Powers, Privileges and Immunities Act 1976, I, MAEIN DEIRERAGEA, Speaker of Parliament, hereby make the following rules :

1. These Rules may be cited as the Parliamentary Powers, Privileges and Immunities Rules, 1996.
2. These Rules shall come into force immediately.
3. The form set out in the Schedule to these Rules shall be used in proceedings before Parliament or a Committee for purposes of Issue of Summons to attend under Section 11 of the Parliamentary Powers, Privileges and Immunities Act, 1976.
