THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE) (PUBLIC SOLICITOR) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2006

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon the Minister by section 3 of the Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) Act, the Minister hereby makes the following regulations -

- Citation 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Public Solicitor)(Amendment)Regulations 2006, and shall be deemed to have come into force on 1st January, 2006.
- Amendment regulation 2. Regulation 4 of the Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Public Solicitor) 4 Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the “principal Regulations”) is hereby amended by deleting the words “an annual taxable salary of \$59,224.75” and substituting therefor the words “a fortnightly taxable salary of \$4,000.00”.
- Appointment grant 3. Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by deleting the figure “\$2,000.00” and substituting therefor the figure “\$10,000.00”.
- Amendment of regulation 7 4. Regulation 7 of the principal regulation is hereby amended by deleting the full stop at the end of the sentence and inserting thereafter the words “or in the absence of a rent free residence, and at the option of the officer he shall receive a housing allowance of \$5,000.00 per month”.
