EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) (NO. 3) REGULATIONS 2021

**EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) (HONIARA EMERGENCY ZONE)
(RESTRICTION OF MOVEMENT OF PERSONS) (NO. 2) (AMENDMENT)
ORDER 2022**

I, Hon. Manasseh Damukana Sogavare, Prime Minister, under regulation 15 of the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (No. 3) Regulations 2021* (Legal Notice No. 318 of 2021), and with reference to sections 36(a) and 65(2) of the *Interpretation and General Provisions Act* (Cap. 85), make the following Order:

1 Citation

This Order may be cited as the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (Honiara Emergency Zone) (Restriction of Movement of Persons) (No. 2) (Amendment) Order 2022*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day it is published in the *Gazette*.

3 Amendment of Legal Notice No. 21 of 2022

This Order amends the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (Honiara Emergency Zone) (Restriction of Movement of Persons) (No. 2) Order 2022* (Legal Notice No. 21 of 2022) (“*Principal Order*”).

4 Paragraph 4 amended

Paragraph 4 of the *Principal Order* is amended by omitting subparagraphs (1) and (2), and substituting:

- “(1) On and from 6.00 pm on Saturday 29 January 2022 until 9.00 am on Sunday 30 January 2022, a person must not enter or leave the emergency zone.
- (2) On and from 6.00 pm on Saturday 29 January 2022 until 9.00 am on Sunday 30 January 2022, a person in the emergency zone must:
- (a) be at the person’s place of residence, and remain there; and
 - (b) not leave or be away from the person’s place of residence.”.
