THE FISHERIES ORDINANCE 1972
(No. 13 of 1972)

THE FISHERIES (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1973

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Fisheries Ordinance 1972, and after consultation with the Governing Council, the High Commissioner hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Amendment) Regulations 1973 and shall come into operation on the 1st August 1973.

2. The Fisheries Regulations 1972 are hereby amended by substituting for regulation 11 the following new regulation:—

“Restriction 11. Any person who fishes by means of a seine, gill or on the use of trawl net within any area specified in the Third Schedule Third Schedule. shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine of “twenty dollars”.

3. The Fisheries Regulations are hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following new Schedule:—

"THIRD SCHEDULE
(regulation 11)

AREAS IN WHICH NET FISHING IS PROHIBITED

Honiara Inner Harbour

All that area of the Honiara Harbour enclosed by a line joining the iron mooring dolphin at the North East end of the deep water quay at Point Cruz to the Easternmost corner of the Shell Company security fence and the High Water mark between those two points."
