**HONIARA CITY ACT  
(NO. 2 of 1999)****HONIARA CITY (ELECTION OF MAYOR) ORDER 2012**

IN exercise of the power conferred upon me by section 72 of the Act, I make the following Order –

1. This Order may be cited as the Honiara City (Election of Mayor) Order 2012 and shall come into force upon publication in the *Gazette*.
2. Whereas the office of the Mayor became vacant under section 8(1)(a) and no provision is made for an election of a Mayor as a result of this vacancy, I order that the election of the Mayor from the elected members of the Honiara City Council be held on the 14th day of September 2012.
3. This Order revokes L/N. No. 29 of 2008.

**HONIARA CITY ACT  
(NO.2 of 1999)**

**HONIARA CITY (ELECTION OF MAYOR)  
(NO.1) ORDER 2012**

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 72 of the Act, I make the following Order—

1. This Order may be cited as the Honiara City (Election of Mayor) (No.1) Order 2012 and shall come into force upon publication in the *Gazette*.

2. Whereas the Honiara City (Election of Mayor) Order 2012\* provides for the election of the Mayor of the Honiara City Council, the following rules shall apply for the purpose of the election of the Mayor –

- (a) all members of the Honiara City Council as specified in section 5 (1)(a), (b), (c) and (d) of the Act, “Membership of the Council” shall be eligible to vote;
- (b) the Mayor shall be elected from amongst the elected members in accordance with section 7(1);
- (c) in the event of the vote for the election of the Mayor’s position being a tie then there shall be a one hour recess;
- (d) after the recess the Council shall resume for the purpose of casting their votes for the position of the Mayor for a second time;

- (e) in the event that the vote is still a tie, then the election shall be countermanded and there shall be a call for fresh nominations for the vacant position of the Mayor by the City Clerk;
- (f) such a new election shall take place within seven(7) days from the 14th day of September 2012.
