POLICE ACT
(NO. 2 OF 2013)

POLICE (AMENDMENT)(NO. 4) REGULATIONS 2020

I, Hon. Anthony Kamutulaka Veke, Minister for Police, National Security and Correctional Services, under section 218 of the *Police Act 2013* and with reference to section 36 and 65(2) of the *Interpretation and General Provisions Act* (Cap. 85), make the following Regulations:

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Police (Amendment)(No. 4) Regulations 2020*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the date they are published in the Gazette.

3 Amendment of Police Regulations 2013

These Regulations amend the Police Regulations 2013 (*“Principal Regulations”*).

4 Schedule 2 amended

Schedule 2 to the Principal Regulations is amended by inserting after the item relating to “Police Maritime Division Officers Special Duty”:

<i>(Type of allowance)</i>	<i>(Ranks)</i>	<i>(Rate)</i>
Border Active Allowance	All ranks	\$150 per day officer carries out duties in an operation at the Solomon Islands international maritime border as authorised by a Commissioner’s Order”.
