**MINUTE OF THE COURT**

[1] This appeal against conviction alleges that there was no factual basis for the jury's verdict. Leave to appeal was refused by the President of the Court of Appeal.

to be prepared. The Crown does not oppose the application for adjournment.


[3] We are prepared to grant an adjournment and we order that the transcripts be prepared.
