

MINUTE

26 April 2013

- 1. This Minute is to record the outcome of this case.
- 2. This was an appeal against both the conviction following trial of the two appellants on a charge of arson and the sentences subsequently imposed.
- 3. At the commencement of the appeal hearing, Mr Wirrick conceded the appeal. This concession recognised that the trial judge critically relied on evidence of statements taken from two co-defendants (who happened to be discharged during the trial) which evidence was inadmissible against the appellants.



- 4. This concession was both responsible and appropriate.
- 5. The appeal was accordingly allowed and the convictions and sentences quashed.
- 6. In the circumstances, there will be no order for a retrial.
