Salvin is dismissed from the case for want of proff Willy is fined £2 and sentenced to-five days of imprisonment. Mousse is fined £1 and sentenced to five days of imprisonment. Costs to be paid by both.

The case of powder that was seized by the officer of Police at Santo is confiscated.
