Storekeeper of Vila. French Ressortissant .

The above named Nabeme Nakandakare stands convicted before the Joint  
Court for that he did on the 6th June 1927 at Vila supply alcoholic  
liquor to wit one bottle of wine to native Pitu contrary to Art.59  
(i) of the Anglo-French Convention of 1914.

his said offence to pay a fine of frs 300 and costs or in default  
thereof imprisonment.
