

ressortissant, Engineer and Storekeeper of Vila.


The above named Kim Sam stands convicted before the Joint Court  
for that he did on June 3rd 1927 supply alcoholic liquor to wit  
2 bottles of beer to the natives Jimmy Torres, and Jimmy Lacona  
contrary to Art. 59 (i) of the Anglo-French Convention of 1914  
Thereupon the Joint Court sentences the said Kim Sam for his said  
offence to pay a fine of frs 250 and costs of the prosecution, or  
in default thereof 15 days imprisonment.
