2. The table of fees in the Ninth Schedule to the Shipping Regulation is hereby deleted and replaced by the following table -

Gross metric tonnage of vessel	For the survey in Vila

Less than 10	2,500
10 and over but less than 25	5,000
25 and over but less than 50	7,500
50 and over but less than 100	10,000
100 and over but less than 150	15,000
150 and over but less than 300	20,000
300 and over but less than 500	25,000
500 and over	30,000

For each additional visit a fee of half the original is payable. For surveys and additional visits to Santo an additional charge of 10,000 FNH is payable.
