**JOINT REGULATION 4 of 1961**

## JOINT REGULATION

No. 4 of  
1961.

To bring into effect the Estimates of the Joint Administration for the year 1961.

[Published: Condominium Gazette No. 210.]

MADE by the British and French Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 5, 7, paragraph 2 of Article 2 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914 and section 5 of the Joint Finance Regulation No. 10 of 1957, after consultation of the Advisory Council and with the approval of the Governments of Her Britannic Majesty and of the French Republic.

1. This Regulation may be cited as the 1961 Appropriation Joint Regulation.

2. The Estimates of the Joint Administration for the year 1961 shall provide for—

- (a) Revenue to the amount of Five Hundred and Sixty Six Thousand Five Hundred Pounds Sterling or One Hundred and Forty One Million Six Hundred and Twenty Five Thousand New Hebrides Francs.
- (b) Expenditure to the amount of Five Hundred and Sixty Six Thousand Five Hundred Pounds Sterling or One Hundred and Forty One Million Six Hundred and Twenty Five Thousand New Hebrides Francs.

3. There shall be issued from general revenue and other funds of the Joint Administration and applied to the service of the year ending 31st December 1961 a sum not exceeding that specified in (b) of section 2 of this Joint Regulation. The said amount shall be appropriated as set out in the schedule to this Joint Regulation.

4. The Ordonnateur shall authorise expenditure and the Treasurer shall pay such sum or sums of money as the Resident Commissioners jointly by warrant from time to time direct for the purpose aforesaid not exceeding on the whole the sum specified in (b) of Section 2.
