

A JOINT REGULATION

To provide for the recovery of certain expenditure incurred in connection with certain Joint Regulations.

Joint Regulation No. 4 of 1920.

WHEREAS by Joint Regulations Nos. 4 of 1909 and 3 of 1919 the Condominium Government is empowered to enforce quarantine on vessels and individuals, and

Whereas it is expedient to provide for the recovery by the Condominium Government of such expenditure as may be incurred in the enforcement of such quarantine.

1. Any expenditure incurred by the Condominium Government in carrying out the provisions of Joint Regulations Nos. 4 of 1909 and 3 of 1919 in connection with the detention in quarantine of any vessel or vessels under sections 10 and 11 of Joint Regulation No. 4 of 1909 and 2, 5 and 6 of Joint Regulation No. 3 of 1919 aforesaid shall be recoverable from the master or owner of such vessel or vessels.

Certain expenditure recoverable.

2. This Regulation shall be known as "The New Hebrides (Quarantine Expenses) Regulation No. 4 of 1920."
