JOINT REGULATION 2 of 1913

A JOINT REGULATION

No. 2 of 1913.

To prohibit the unauthorised collection and removal of certain material from Vila Harbour.

1. From the date of the coming into force of this Regulation it shall be unlawful to collect gather excavate or remove from the shores of Vila Harbour any sand earth coral or stone without the authority in writing previously obtained of the Resident Commissioners jointly.

Collection and removal of material prohibited.

2. For the purpose of this Regulation the term "Vila Harbour" shall mean and include that part of the sea front of the eastern side of such Harbour lying between the coffee store of the Société Française des Nouvelles-Hébrides (Pakora) on the North and the Rodin property (Nankery) on the South which is daily covered and uncovered by the sea at high and low tides respectively.

Definition of term Harbour.

3. Any person who shall be proved on conviction before the Joint Court of a breach of the provisions of this Regulation shall be liable to the payment of a fine not exceeding twenty pounds and to suffer a term of imprisonment not exceeding thirty days or to one or other of these penalties.

Penalties.

4. Breaches of this Regulation shall be reported by the officers and agents of the Police duly authorised in that behalf by the Resident Commissioners conjointly.

Infractions to be reported by Police officer.

5. This Regulation shall come into force on the first day of October one thousand nine hundred and thirteen and may be cited for all purposes as the "New Hebrides (Vila Harbour) Regulation No. 2 of 1913".

Date of coming into force.
