JOINT REGULATION

No. 6 of 1938.

To provide for the use of a new issue of stamps for postal purpose in the New Hebrides.

WE, His Britannic Majesty's Resident Commissioner and the Resident Commissioner for the French Republic in the New Hebrides DO HEREBY MAKE the following Joint Regulation:

1. Postage stamps issued by the New Hebrides Condominium and having face values of 5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30, 40 and 50 gold centimes and 1, 2, 5 and 10 gold francs respectively may after the thirty-first day of May, 1938, be used for the payment of all postal charges concurrently with or in substitution for the postage stamps at present in use.

Issue of Gold Currency Stamps.

2. (a) The price in French currency of such stamps shall be the amount obtained by multiplying the face value thereof by a coefficient which shall from time to time be determined by the Resident Commissioners and declared by Joint Decision.

French price of stamps.

(b) The price in English sterling and Australian currencies respectively of such stamps shall be the equivalent in such currencies at the official Condominium rate of exchange of the French price thereof.

Sterling and Australian price of stamps.

3. This Regulation shall come into force on the day of the date hereof and may be cited as "The New Hebrides Postage Stamp Regulation No. 6 of 1938".

Date of coming into force and Short Title.
