JOINT REGULATION 6 of 1929

A JOINT REGULATION

No. 6 of 1929.

to provide for the constitution of a Sanitary Commission.

Published: Condominium Gazette No. 30 with amendment by J.R. of 1931 (Gazette 43).]

WHEREAS it is expedient to make provision for the better sanitation of the town of Vila.

1. A Sanitary Commission composed of not more than seven members of whom the Condominium Medical Officer shall be the President shall be nominated by Joint Decision of the Resident Commissioners.

Constitution of a Sanitary Commission.

2. The Sanitary Commission shall advise the Resident Commissioners in respect of all questions affecting the sanitation of the town of Vila, and shall also submit to the Resident Commissioner such recommendations as they may deem necessary.

Duties of Commission.

3. The sanitary Commission shall make such inspections of the town in the interests of Public Health as shall appear necessary, and for that purpose shall be empowered to enter upon any premises irrespective of the nationality of the occupant. The result of such inspection shall be reported to the Resident Commissioners.

Inspections.

Any infraction of existing Regulations established during the course of such inspections shall be reported to the competent authority for necessary action.

Report of infractions.

4. For the carrying out of the provisions of section 3 of this Regulation the Sanitary Commission shall be deemed as constituted by the presence of the President and one British and one French member.

Composition of Commission.

5. Any person or person obstructing or interfering with the Sanitary Commission in the execution of their duties shall be guilty of an offence under this Regulation, and shall be liable upon conviction before a Court of First Instance, or until such Court has been proclaimed, before the Joint Court, to a fine not exceeding [twenty pounds, (2,480 francs)] and to imprisonment not exceeding one month or to the one other of those penalties.

Penalty for obstruction.

6. Joint Regulations dated the 7th and 30th December, 1912, hereby repealed.

Regulations repealed.

7. This Regulation shall come into force on the date of publication, and may be cited for all purposes as the "New Hebrides Sanitary Commission Regulation No. 6 of 1929".
