

NEW HEBRIDES CONDOMINIUM

JOINT REGULATION

No. 19 of 1978

TO PUT INTO EFFECT the Resolution of the Representative Assembly No. 15 of 1978, passed the 15th day of December 1978, relating to the budgetary and financial provisions for the year 1979.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Article 2 : 2 and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914 and Article 28 (3) of the Exchange of Notes made at London the fifteenth day of September 1977 between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the French Republic.

Scheduled Resolution put into effect.      1.      The Resolution of the Representative Assembly No. 15 of 1978, set forth in the attached Schedule, is hereby put into effect.

Short title and commencement.      2.      This Joint Regulation may be cited as the Budgetary and Financial Provisions Regulation 1979 and shall come into operation on the 1st January 1979.

RESOLUTION No. 15 of 1978

relating to the budgetary and financial provisions for the year 1979.

The Representative Assembly of the New Hebrides, at its sitting on the 15th day of December 1978, hereby resolves and decides, in accordance with article 23 of the Exchange of Notes of the fifteenth day of September 1977, to adopt the following measures :

Amount of  
Budget

1. The revenue and expenditure of the recurrent budget of the Government of the New Hebrides for the year 1979 shall be balanced at one billion, two hundred and sixty five million, eight hundred and forty three thousand New Hebrides francs (FNH. 1.265.243.000) or the equivalent thereof in pounds sterling at the current rate of exchange.

2. There shall be issued from General Revenue and other funds of the Government and applied for the service of the year ending on the 31st day of December 1979, a sum not exceeding the amount specified in Section 1 and the same shall be appropriated as set out in the Schedule hereto.

3. Subject to the powers of the Representative Assembly, the Government may authorise the Treasurer to control expenditure and revenue of the Budget for 1979 in accordance with the provisions of the Joint Regulation No. 10 of 1957 within the limits defined by such authorisation and such expenditure shall not exceed the amount specified in Section 1.

Emergency

credits

4. In urgent cases and when the Assembly is not in session, additional credits not exceeding five million New Hebridean francs (FNH 5.000.000) may be opened in 1979 by decision of the Minister of Finance. Such decisions shall, as soon as possible, be tabled to the Representative Assembly or to the General Committee for approval.
