JOINT REGULATION

No. 5 of 1976

TO AMEND the Joint Taxis Regulation No. 36 of 1966,
as amended.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions
of Articles 2:2 and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. Subsection (1) of section 5 of the Joint Taxis Regulation No. 36 of 1966 (hereinafter called "the principal Regulation") is hereby repealed and replaced by the following subsection :
 "(1) No person may drive or cause or allow any taxi unless he be the owner thereof and holds a valid public vehicle licence in respect of such vehicle and otherwise then in accordance with the conditions attached to such licence."

2. Section 5 of the principal Regulation is hereby further amended by the addition of the following new subsection :
 "(5) Where the public vehicle in respect of which a public vehicle licence has been issued is a taxi, the licence shall require the owner of the vehicle to place such vehicle at the disposal of the public for at least eight hours per day on at least five days in each week and if the District Agents are satisfied that the owner of the vehicle has wilfully failed to observe this requirement they may withdraw the licence."

3. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Taxis (Amendment) Regulation No. 5 of 1976 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
