CHAPTER 20

THE PRISONERS (RELEASE ON LICENCE)  
ORDER No. 28 OF 1991

An Order to provide for the release of prisoner ANTOINETTE COULON.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 30 of the Prisons (Administration) Act [CAP 20], 1, IOLU JOHNSON ABBIL, Minister of Home Affairs and Minister responsible for Prisons, HEREBY MAKE the following Order:-

**RELEASE OF PRISONER ON LICENCE**

1. ANTOINETTE COULON who is currently being held in custody as a prisoner, shall be set free and released from prison on the 9th day of October, 1991 SUBJECT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS set out in sections 2 and 3 of this Order.

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF RELEASE**

2. The following terms and conditions shall apply:-
  - (a) ANTOINETTE COULON shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour for a period commencing on the day of her release being the 9th day of October, 1991 and ending on the 4th day of April, 1993, which period is hereinafter called "the relevant period".
  - (b) In the event that ANTOINETTE COULON should commit a criminal offence during the relevant period, whether or not the offence is of a similar nature as that for which ANTOINETTE COULON's original prison sentence was ordered by the Court or, the Court before which ANTOINETTE COULON appears for such new offence orders a prison sentence, ANTOINETTE COULON shall automatically be recalled and returned to prison.

**PROCEDURES RELATING TO VIOLATIONS OF CONDITIONS OR RELEASE, RECALL TO PRISON, ETC.**

3. In every case where the provisions of paragraph (b) of section 2 apply, the following procedures shall apply :
  - (a) Where the Minister is satisfied that ANTOINETTE COULON has violated the terms and conditions set out in section 2 the Minister shall issue a Notice in writing directing that ANTOINETTE COULON is returned to custody forthwith;

- (b) A Notice issued by the Minister shall be served on ANTOINETTE COULON directing her to return to prison at such time and on such day as specified in the Notice;
- (c) ANTOINETTE COULON when returned to prison in accordance with this section shall be obliged to serve the unexpired term of her original sentence which she would have had to serve if she had not been released in accordance with this Order;
- (d) ANTOINETTE COULON when returned to prison in accordance with this section is not entitled to have part of her original unexpired term of sentence remitted.

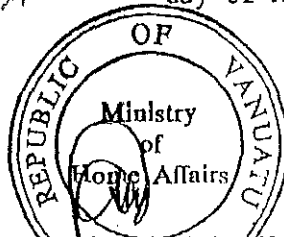
**COMMISSIONER OF POLICE AND SUPERINTENDENT OF PRISONS TO ENFORCE DIRECTIONS OF THE MINISTER**

- 4. The Commissioner of Police and the Superintendent of Prisons shall take all lawful measures required or necessary to enforce every Direction or Notice issued by the Minister under this Order.

**COMMENCEMENT**

- 5. This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 9th day of October, 1991.
