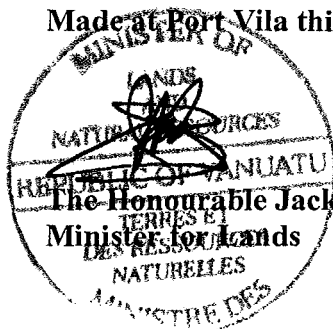
1 Land Tribunal Members
