of the Hereditary Estate-Holders, the Ministry of Lands is not confident that it is in a position to provide any information on inaccurate for this report to make any estimation of the total land area for each Estate-Holder. Without the express consent roads/road reserves, cemeteries and coastal areas affected by the high water mark. Therefore, it would be inappropriate and Hereditary Estates also compromised land that is deemed to be Crown Land because of land being used for public purposesis that there are additional estates that the Hereditary Estate-Holders hold. Another reason is that a substantial proportion of Land Act in Schedule 1 does not clearly set out the area and boundaries of each estate. The other reason, as explained above, As a result, the total area of a hereditary estate (tofi'a) cannot be accurately provided to the Commission. This is because the

For the reasons outlined below, the total area of Crown Estates cannot also be accurately calculated.

- on one allotment which is simply added on as a new register. The table includes registered allotments where the previous landholder(s) has not been deregistered from the record - these landholders having already died or surrendered their allotments. Therefore there may be multiple registers

Therefore, the information shown in the tables reflects more land being registered then is the realistic situation.
